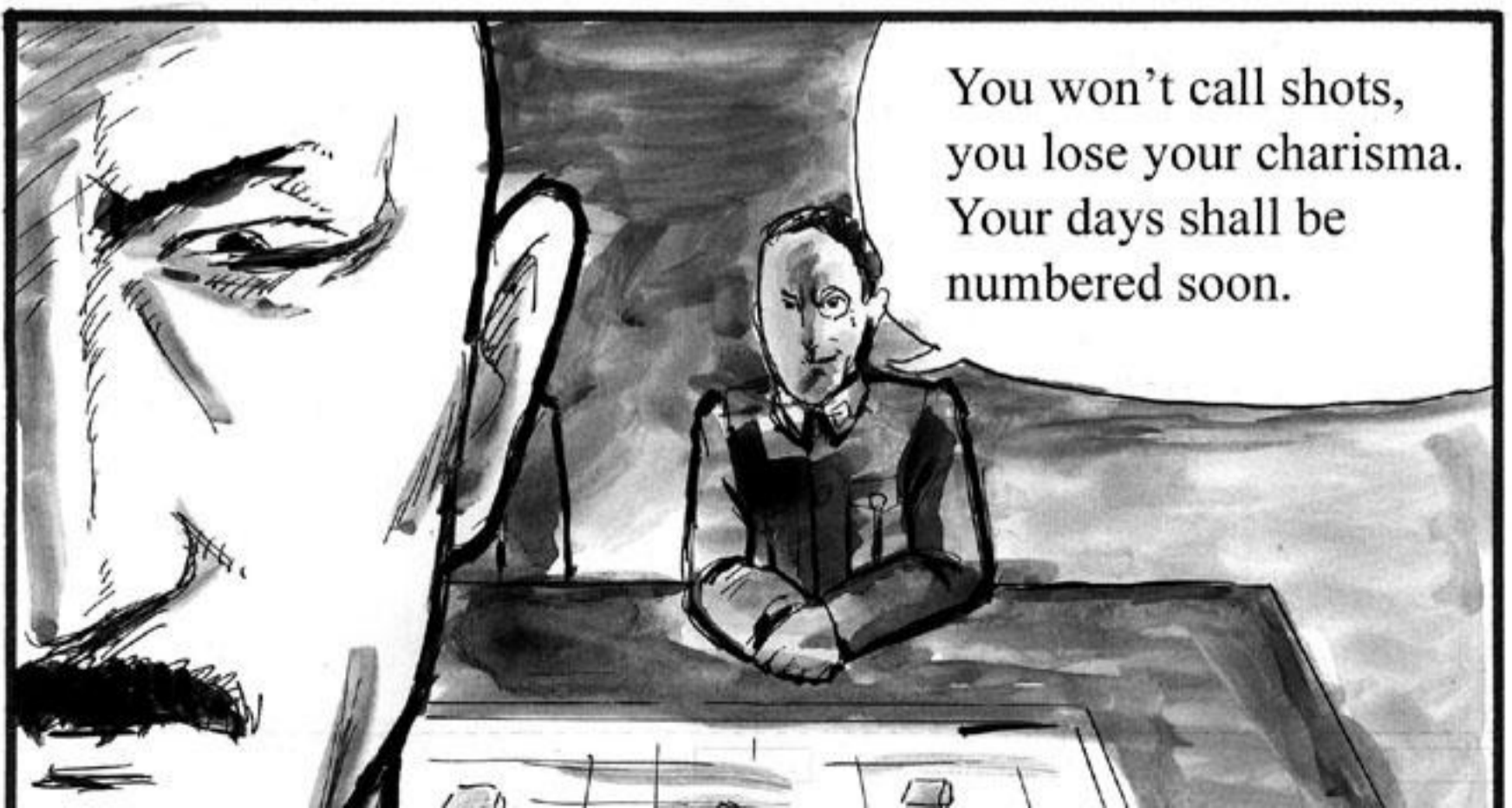


If so, I'm gonna be a national hero.

Shut up, you Germans !

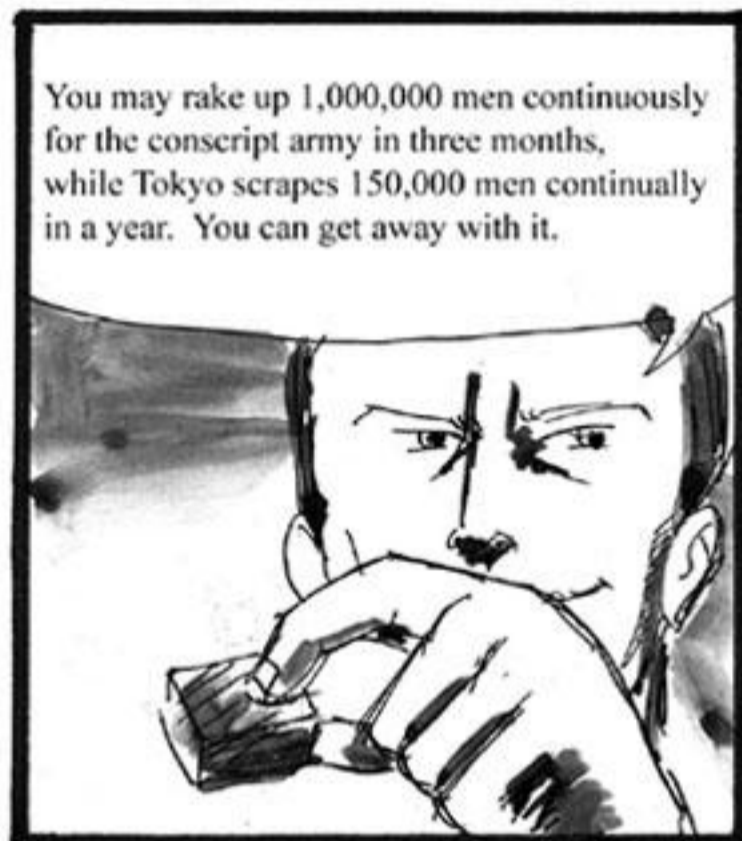
I know you have certain realities with Moscow. You may be pleased when I and Japan get into a never-ending incremental struggle.



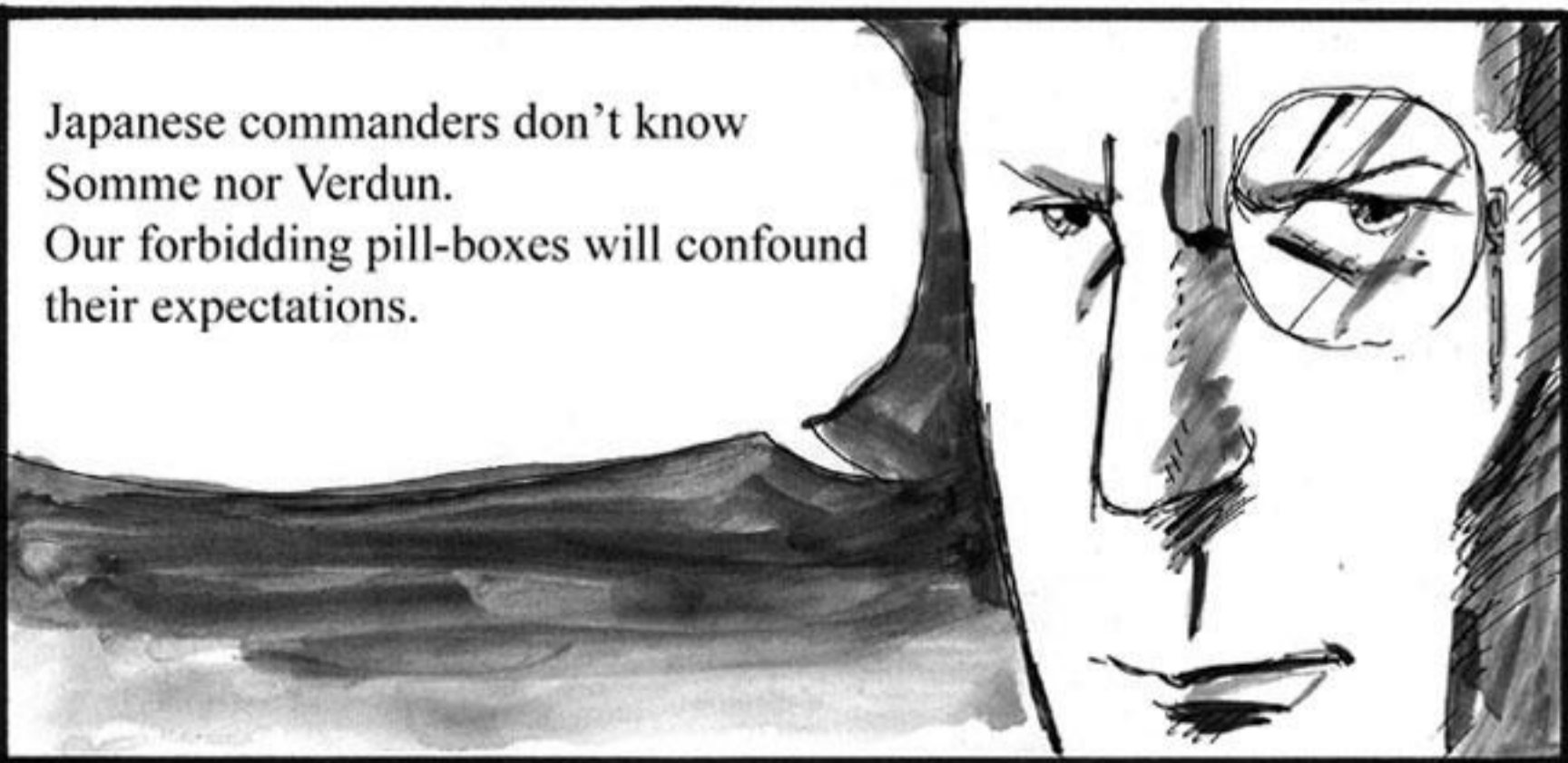
You know, the more the merrier, Fuhrer Chiang. We designed the latest pill-boxes for you. It's the panacea. A talisman to invoke.

I believe.



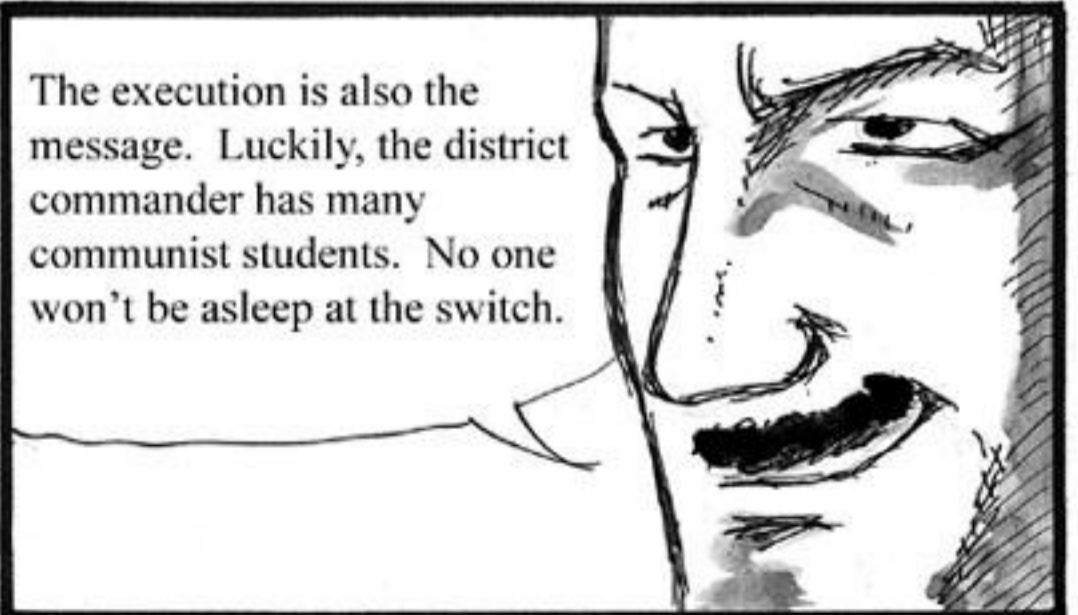

won't be asleep at the switch.



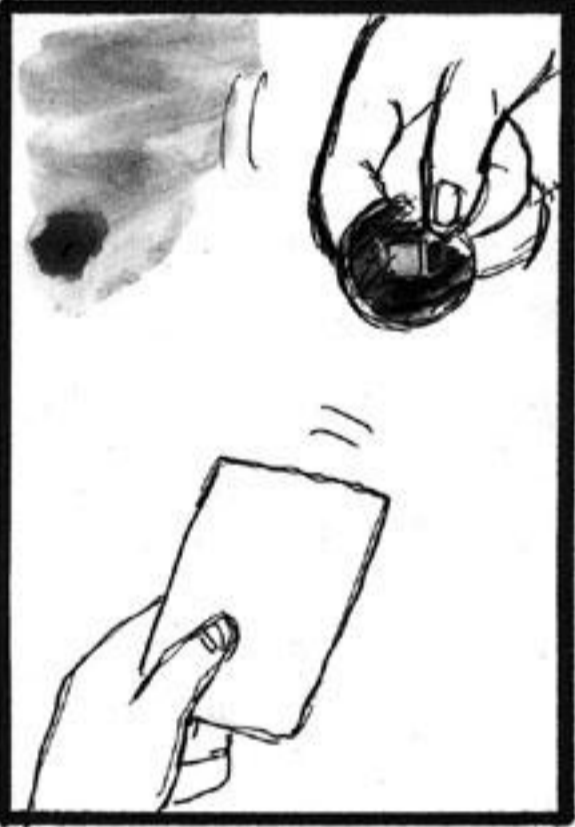
